Established in 2010 by G.Tactix & LXP, Run Tingz Recordings is a UK based record label and artist collective that showcases and represents a unique brand of Reggae influenced Jungle & Drum n Bass.

Striving to promote the links between these two diverse cultures, the label is committed to working and collaborating with artists within both communities. With world leading Jungle, Drum n Bass and Reggae artists on board and an international distribution deal signed with the mighty Nu-Urban Music their sound is set to go global. You will find all releases at all good record shops and online / digital music outlets throughout the world.

The Run Tingz Cru

Made up from two of the labels performing artists (G.Tactix & LXP), Blackout J.A. and a selection of the crew's guest vocalists, the Run Tingz Cru is an artist

collective with a unique style of Reggae influenced electronic dance music. Taking inspiration from the old school Jungle sound of the 90's and bringing it up to date with the heavy bass lines and modern production techniques that are dominating the airwaves, the cru is already receiving support from leading playaz in the scene and has a host of live performances and an appearance on BBC Introducing under their belt.

The cru's debut release on Run Tingz Recordings "The Jungle Champion EP" was an instant hit and is busy tearing up dance floors around the planet. Their remixes of YT's 2009 reggae anthem "Born Inna Babylon" is set to place them firmly on the map and is already receiving widespread support and radio plays from stations including KOOL FM London.

2011 is already shaping up to be a defining year for the cru with Run Tingz 003 "Informer" (a collaboration of the legendary Reggae artist Blackout J.A. and the fast up and coming Grime MC K.ners) due for release at the beginning of Spring (2011). Beyond that remixes of YT's Hustler and a host of other projects (including releases with Congo Natty legends Topcat and Lady MC) make the crew from Bristol one to watch.

Blackout J.A.

Blackout Ja is a dynamic performer and is considered revolutionary in his approach to music, using his voice as a tool to fight oppression, set the captives free and edutain. Growing up in a musical household in Jamaica, he was exposed to various styles of music from a young age. He would hear his mother sing in a choir at church or be in the surroundings of his father and friends with their sound system.

Blackout has worked along side international Reggae stars like Sly & Robbie, Tanya Stevens, Freddie McGregor, Luciano, Lukie D and Gregory Issacs. Within the last 5 years he has performed alongside, Sean Paul, Sisqo & Dru Hill, Courtney Pine, Beris Hammond, Buju Banton, Mighty Diamonds, Big Youth, Luciano, Julian Marley, Barington Levy, The Beatnuts, Aswad, Mikey Dread, Macka B, Culture, Misty Roots among many other great acts.

In addition to his Reggae legacy, Blackout is set to take the Jungle scene by storm. His unique style of ruff vocals and conscious lyrics have star qualities and with further singles and an album already well into production he is poised to take his place as the next big thing in UK Jungle music.
